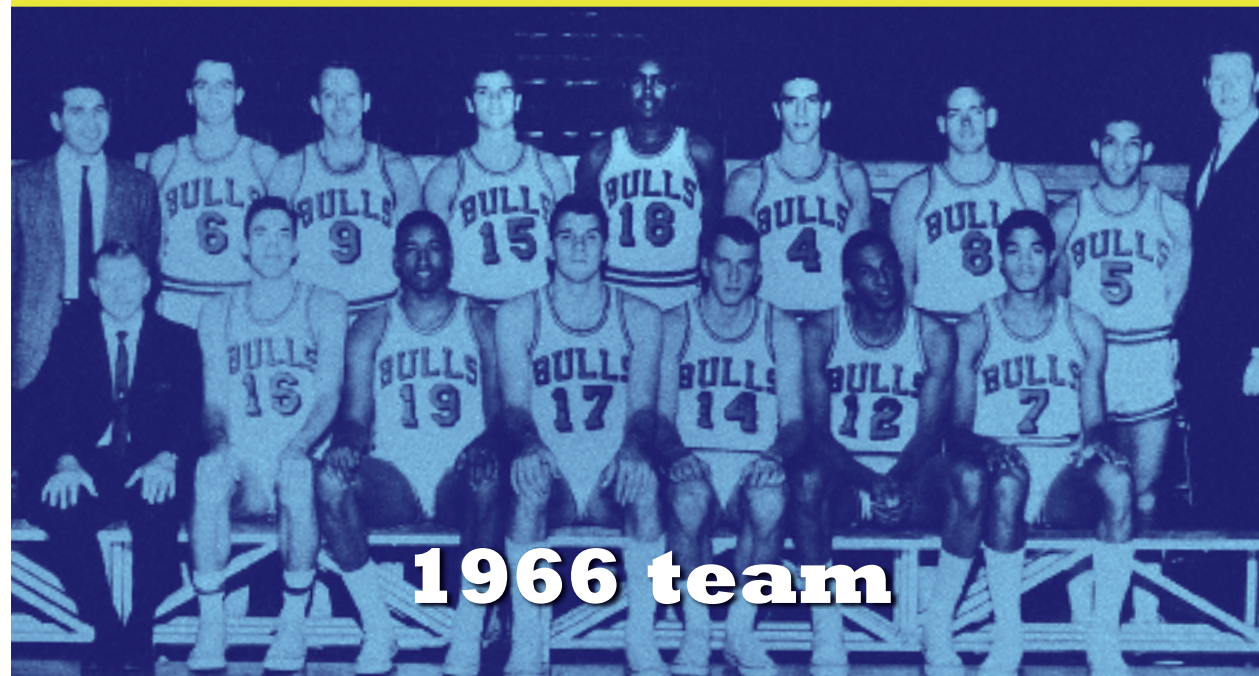
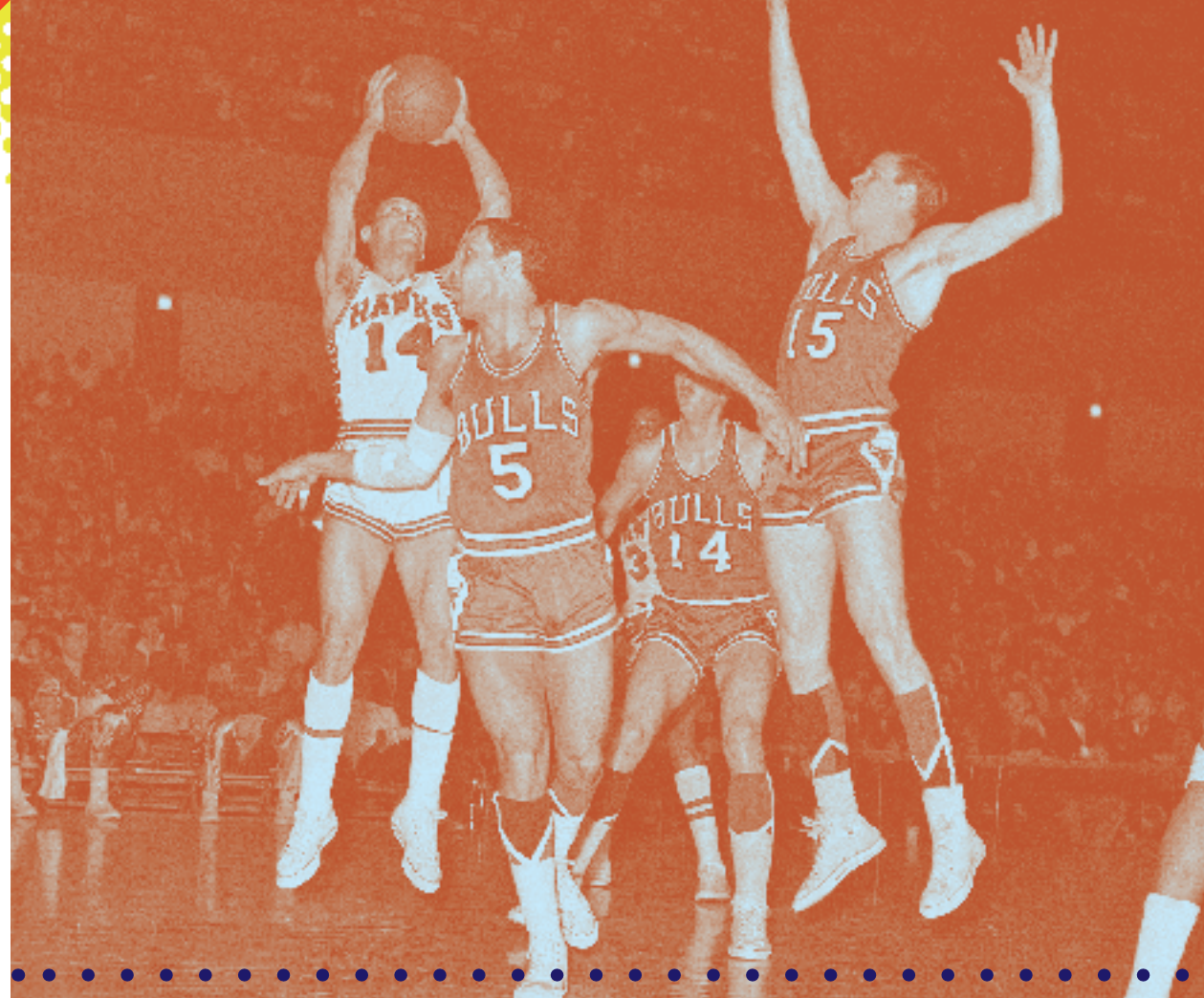
On the COURT

Money Makers

The Bulls team does more than play ball. It also earns a lot of money. In 2018, it was worth \$2.9 billion. That was the fourth-highest **net worth** in the NBA. Teams make money through ticket sales and TV deals. They also sell items with the team **logo** on them.
