

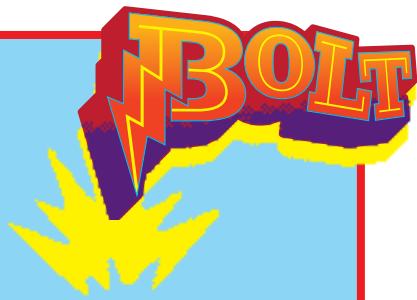

It was after midnight. A boy and his family were sleeping. Suddenly, the family's dog went crazy. Their poodle barked and barked. The barking woke the boy.

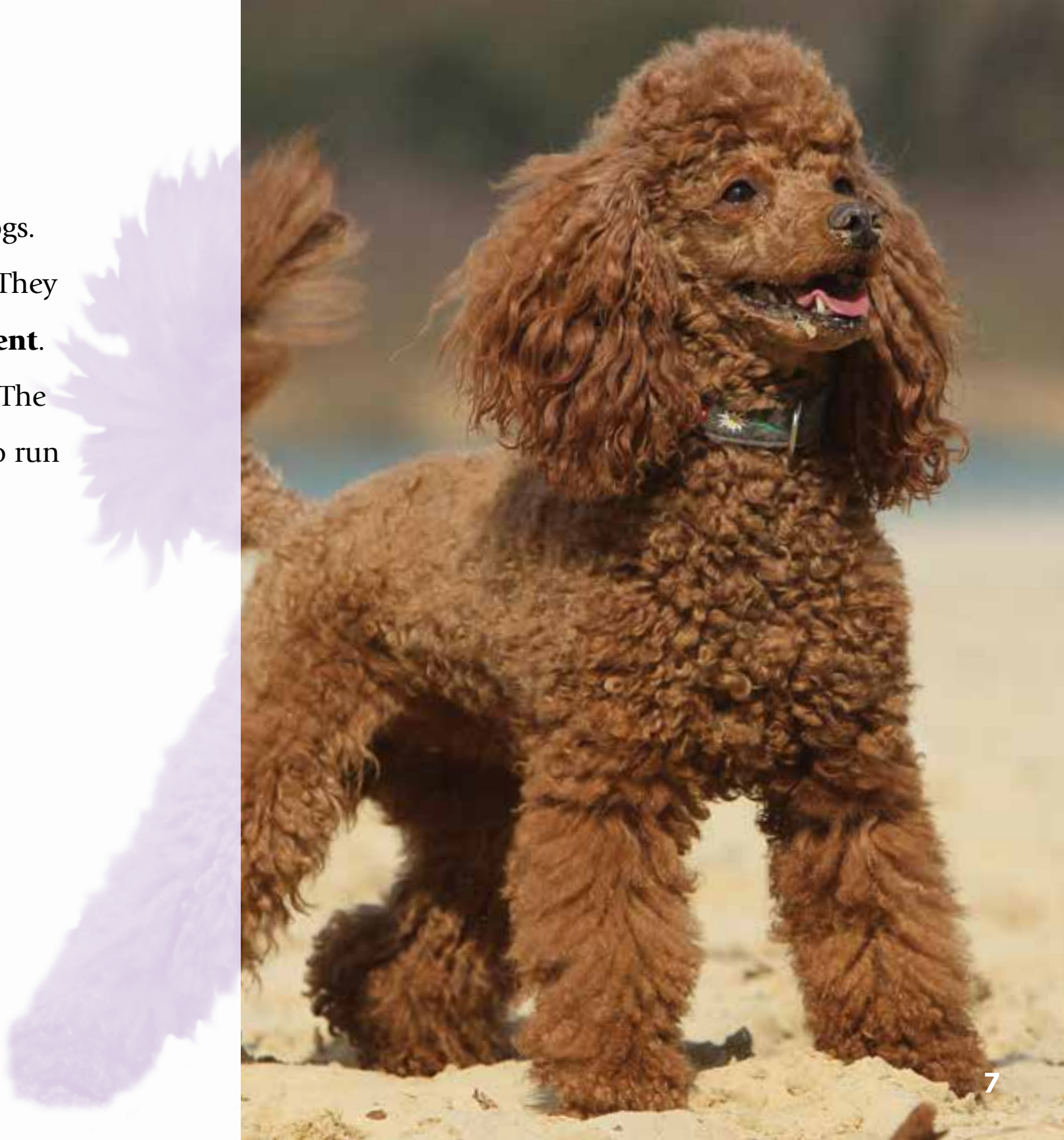
The boy saw someone through the window. He called 911. The police came. They said someone had robbed a house nearby. But the family's house was safe because of the dog.

Powerful Watchdogs

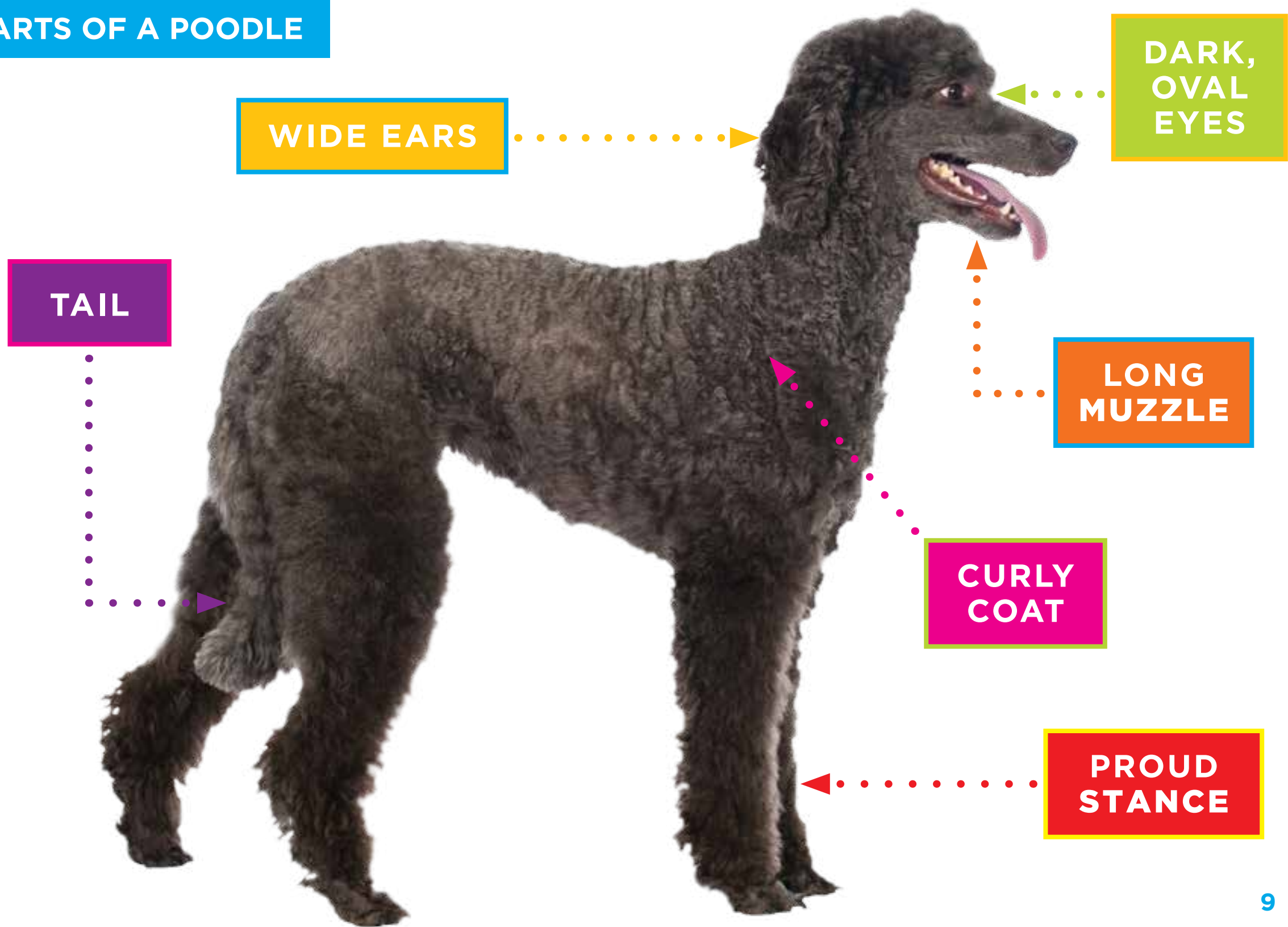
Poodles are very good watchdogs. They have a great sense of smell. They bark if they don't **recognize** a **scent**.
