Pugs are sweet, loving pups. They will follow their owners everywhere. These little dogs like to play. But they tire out easily. Pugs would rather cuddle than run.

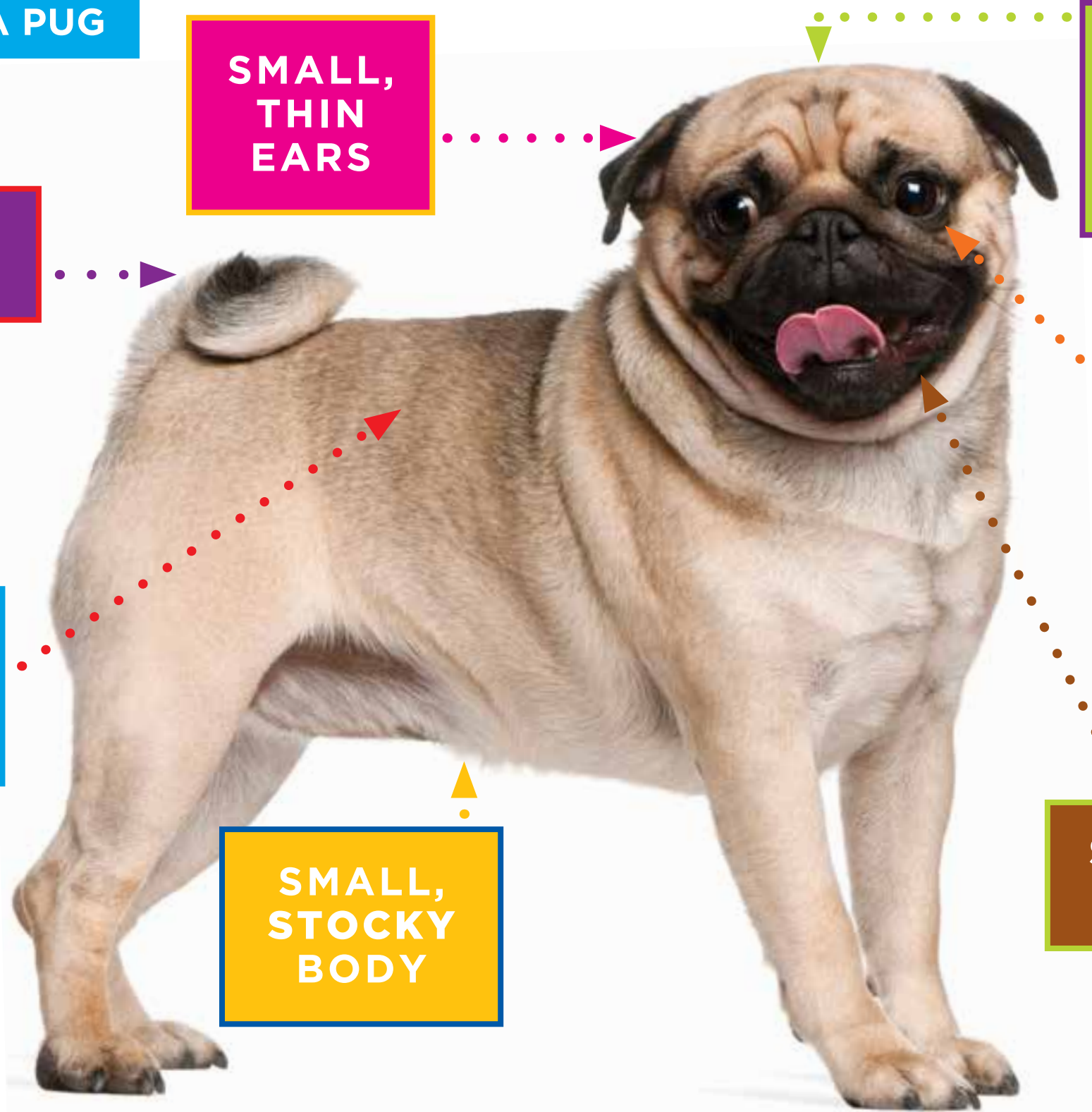
